#### A Wondrous Journey

The purpose of this study is to explore nature landscape and consequently, understand how nature works. To understand this, one needs to ask one's self two important questions: What do my personal interpretations of my work mean? What kind of elements would I want to express my inner world in my garden scenery painting?

These questions are addressed by the artist in order to understand the whole artwork, smoothening the creative process. In this work, the image of a sunflower stands out as a dominant subject in this work. I was inspired to create a garden art series crafted entirely from my imagination. The sight of flowers is somewhat therapeutic to me.

I have some deep reservations over how to convey what I have in my mind, in my memory specifically, I desire to have a sense of proportion relative to point of view as well as a level of factual concentration and realism to be expressed in my works.

The subject of sunflowers has been used by the masters like Van Gogh, Claude Monet and Anselm Kiefer. Each of them has created masterpieces using this subject, and I hope to follow in their footsteps by creating my own secret garden where I can play with my imagination, using composition and colour as I go.

Claude Monet once said, "For me, a landscape does not exist in its own right, since its appearance changes at every moment; but the surrounding atmosphere brings it to life...The air and the light which vary continually. For me, it is only the surrounding atmosphere which gives subjects their true value."

My investigation has resulted in a painting with my personal interpretation of its physical and emotional landscape. My brush strokes have recreated a landscape captured by my imagination. It is my inner world, with a linear texture and elements in harmony. The colours used are dark, pastel, appropriate for a painting with romantic elements to it.

The distinct shape of a sunflower is visible, utilising space and harmony that emerges by layering linear brush strokes, something based on the fauvism element movement. The colours denote the mood and the shape defines the structure of the artwork. My work speaks of a romantic and sweet memory, based on how I see it.

To sum things up, in recreating a natural garden based on personal and emotional attachment, I have created numerous explorative paintings. They are the results of experiments, using limited materials to create different textures and effects. With layers after layers staining the canvas, each one is different from its predecessor and successor.

It is interesting to watch as the painting comes together in a long but rewarding process. Through my hard work, I have learnt to understand the materials I have used, how to arrange a good composition and to reconstruct visuals. I can only hope that these lessons will prove valuable to me in the near future.


